Mark Clifton

Mark is the executive director of church replanting and rural strategy at the North American Mission Board, the teaching pastor at Linwood Baptist Church, and a visiting professor at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. His experience includes serving as the lead mission strategist for the Kansas-Nebraska Convention, leading church planting efforts in the regions of North Metro Atlanta, GA, serving as a church planter in Montreal, Quebec, and as a Southern Baptist National Church Planting Missionary for eastern Canada, and leading Southern Baptist church planting projects west of the Mississippi.
