



Aloha! It's time to register for our **3rd Annual Keiki Camp** to be held at Pu'u Kahea Conference Center! Our theme this year will be **GLOW IN THE DARK: Trusting God When We're Scared**. We hope you will allow your keiki to join us for this life-changing week filled with Bible study and worship, fun activities, and new friends! Please fully read the following information and sign/date the bottom of the page acknowledging that you have read and understand.

- ✔ This is a drop-off, overnight camp for Keiki who have completed 2<sup>nd</sup> grade through completed 6<sup>th</sup> grade.
- ✔ Our PKCC Staff and Volunteers will staff the camp. Matt Lincoln will be our Camp Pastor.
- ✔ Check in from 3 - 5 PM on Tuesday, June 5. Closing Celebration will be at 9:30 AM on Saturday, June 9. All are invited!
- ✔ All Keiki are expected to stay at camp the entire time. Pulling them out for extracurricular activities is a disruption to camp and will not be allowed.
- ✔ Cost is \$170. A **\$50 NON-REFUNDABLE** deposit will be required when turning in the registration form. Remaining balance may be paid at any time between registration date and first day of camp. Sibling discount is \$10 off per child.
- ✔ The registration fee covers lodging, meals, t-shirt, water bottle, all activities and supplies.
- ✔ Campers should bring their own Bible, bedding, toiletries, swimsuit, beach towel, bath towel, pillow, and closed toed shoes for games.
- ✔ NO PHONES, iPADS, OR ELECTRONICS WILL BE ALLOWED. If found, these will be held by camp staff until the end of the week.
- ✔ Christ-like and positive behavior is expected from each camper at all times. ***Any deviation from positive behavior will first be handled by PKCC and camp staff, and if no visible change or improvement is made, the parents will be called to pick up child from camp immediately.***
- ✔ Each camper will be checked for fever and head lice by our camp nurse at check in. Any camper with either of these conditions will not be allowed to stay.
- ✔ Mail both pages of this document, along with deposit to PKCC (address on following page).
- ✔ ***We only have 40 female camper spots and 40 male camper spots available.*** Registration is on a first come-first served basis. **REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS MAY 1, 2018** or until all spots are full. Please register early to ensure your child is accepted. Registrations received after camp is full will be returned or put on a waiting list.

## SKILL BREAKOUT ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS

*All breakouts are for any skill levels! All materials are provided for all breakouts.*

- ✔ **DRAWING & PAINTING**: **NEW FOR 2018!** Have you always wanted to be an artist? Campers will learn basic drawing skills on Day 1, including drawing people, animals and landscape. Days 2 and 3 will consist of painting a picture on canvas loosely based on a famous painting/painter (TBD). Campers will be led by a staff instructor and will have a fantastic painting and drawings to showcase at our Closing Celebration!
- ✔ **MAD SCIENTIST**: **NEW FOR 2018!** Science experiments, brain teasers, logic games and more! Let's get messy as we explore science like you may have never seen before! Campers will be observing and participating in fun (and educational...shhh) science experiments, solving puzzles and more. So, get your goggles ready for a "explosive" time!
- ✔ **ARCHERY/OUTDOOR SKILLS**: Our most popular breakout! Campers will be taught how to shoot with a compound bow, as well as learn outdoor skills while waiting for their turn to shoot. This breakout is led by a skilled archery instructor we bring in to teach the campers. (closed-toed shoes required)
