

Sue Nishikawa Offering for Hawaii Pacific Missions



Funds Request Instructions

The purpose of the Sue Nishikawa Offering for Hawaii Pacific Missions is to promote evangelism and outreach, encourage new work, establish missions, strengthen churches, and support ongoing missions. The offering is to promote a spirit of Ohana through awareness of missions needs and the sharing of the results of those programs and institutions that have received funding. The funds from this offering also provide financial assistance to education institutions affiliated or partnering with the Hawaii Pacific Baptist Convention or for leadership development courses for certification or credit.

The Woman's Missionary Union (WMU) Allocations Committee will prayerfully consider each request and submit their recommendation to the HPBC Executive Director for approval.

Please note the following application guidelines/requirements:

- 1. Applications should be made online at hpbaptist.net/sue-nishikawa-request-form
- 2. The ministry that will be supported should be affiliated with at least one of the following:
 - a. The Hawaii Pacific Baptist Convention (HPBC)
 - b. A local Baptist association affiliated with the HPBC
 - c. An HPBC affiliated church.
 - (Ministries that are not affiliated with one of the above are not eligible for consideration.)
- 3. Provide a Federal Tax ID # for the organization to whom the check is to be made payable.
- 4. Checks will only be made payable to the affiliated church or organization (not individuals).
- 5. Please include specific details about how funds will be spent if approved.
- 6. Applications should be endorsed by the pastor of the sponsoring church.

Post-ministry report: By requesting funds you are committing to submit a ministry report within 90 days of completing the event, project, or ministry. If the project is ongoing, please submit a report of how the ministry is progressing. Explain how the funds were used and give outcomes (Decisions for Christ, recommitments, etc.). If a report is not received by the end of the year, future funding may not be considered.

We encourage you to partner with your association or network of churches in ministry. Your participation in both the general association meetings and other HPBC organizations will provide opportunities to share about your ministry and network with people in your area who can assist you.

Please do not request funds for buildings, salaries, or out-of-state mission trips from this fund.
