

Feeding Guidelines during Covid-19 Pandemic

Distributing Food from One Location

1. Those over 60 or those with medical conditions should not participate.
2. Giving out canned goods rather than hot meals is recommended. Hot meals must be kept above a certain temperature.
3. Refrigerated items need to be kept on ice to avoid spoilage.
4. Wipe down all canned goods and containers with disinfectant wipes.
5. Everyone in your group should wear a mask (save N-95 masks for medical personnel).
6. Wipe all surfaces down often.
7. Have client remain in car. Place food in the trunk or back seat.

Delivering Food to Various Locations

1. Those over 60 or those with medical conditions should not participate.
2. Wipe down all canned goods and containers with disinfectant wipes.
3. Everyone participating should wear a mask (save N-95 masks for medical personnel).
4. Ring the doorbell or knock, then step back 6 feet.
5. Introduce yourself, where you are from and why you are there.
6. Do not leave food at the door if no one is home.
